

**GUIDELINES FOR RCFCA HUNTING POLICY**  
**Adopted December 2003**

The following guidelines are for those individuals receiving approval to hunt on the Open Space of the RCFCA per our Hunting Policy, and become part of the policy:

a) Access to Open Space may only be obtained via Open Space, unless you have explicit permission from a homeowner to cross their property.

b) The Open Space behind Rosewood may only be accessed via the Open Space on Masters Way. Access from the cul-de-sac via the edge of the Hineman property, is not permitted.

c) The removal of a deer must be inconspicuous, i.e. it must be covered and not distinguishable by neighbors, especially children. A deer may not be removed in an open trailer, or placed on a car or truck without being covered and not distinguishable.

d) Remains of a deer must be either buried or otherwise covered (or removed for disposal) so that someone walking in the woods does not stumble across them inadvertently. Also, any blood remains should be rendered inconspicuous.

e) Failure to follow these guidelines could result in disciplinary action by the Board up to and including suspension or revocation of hunting privileges.
